

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR FAIRTIME CAMPING SPACE

1. **Registration:** All persons wishing to stay on the fairgrounds must register by completing a contract with the fair office prior to the fair. Spaces will not be reserved without payment (inside or outside of fence) or without length of the recreational vehicle specified. There will only be one RV space available to each exhibitor, vendor, concessionaire, entertainment, etc. There will be a limited amount of spaces with hook ups.
2. **Parking/Setup:** Starting Monday prior to the fair opening, recreational vehicles will be brought in through RV Gate from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM, unless other arrangements have been made and approved by the CEO of the Fair Association in advance
 - a. **DO NOT** park without the campground attendant or someone from the office giving you permission.
 - b. The campground attendant has the right to assign spaces and change any assignment as the person best sees fit.
 - c. Recreational vehicles will be assigned a specific location and must stay there for the duration of the fair.
 - d. Parking permits will be distributed upon entering and setting up. This permit must be in a visible location on the recreational vehicle at all times.
 - e. All recreational vehicles must park parallel to and within the markers of the assigned space.
3. **Length/Width of RV:** No recreational vehicle may go over the allotted length/width allowed in a space due to fire lane restrictions. The total length and width (maximum space to be used) must be accurate on the front of the contract or you may be asked to remove your recreation vehicle from the RV Park. If your recreational vehicle is more than 32 feet long there will be an additional \$5.00 per night.
4. **Vehicles:** Each RV space will be allowed one vehicle parking pass for \$12.00 per night (this includes storage units for vendors). Each camper is to display the vehicle pass on the dash when parking in this area. A vehicle *may not* park in a camping space or in any of the roadways within the camping area. There will be a specific area to park the extra vehicles this information will be available from the campground attendant. Each club or chapter will be allowed to have one horse/livestock trailer parked in the RV Park area for feed storage purposes only. ***At no time is another vehicle or a fire lane to be blocked.*** Vehicles parked illegally (in camping area, in front of gates, etc.) will be towed away at the owner's expense. Vehicles with valid handicapped placard will be accommodated when possible; please check with fair management.
5. **Liability:** Areas are to be kept clean and fire-hazard free (no open flames). The 10-A District Agricultural Association/Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair is not held liable for any theft or property damage that occurs in the RV Park area. There are no dogs allowed in the RV Park unless it has been approved by Fair Management. There is **no alcohol** allowed on the fairgrounds. Violations will be handled by the campground attendant and Fair Management with immediate expulsion from the fairgrounds.
6. **Curfew:** All persons who remain on the fairgrounds at night must be in their RV by midnight. No disturbances will be tolerated. Violators of this rule will be removed from the grounds and their premiums withheld, if applicable. There must be an adult of at least 25 yrs of age in staying each recreational vehicle each night.
7. **After Fair:** All RV's must be removed from the fairgrounds by the Monday following the fair unless approved by fair management.

NOTE: The fair maintains a zero-tolerance policy regarding minors in possession of alcohol and drugs. All violators will be removed along with their livestock and any premiums will be forfeited.
