



Tulelake-Butte Valley Fairgrounds June 20th, 2009

It is our determination to give the youth involved in this show an educational experience in raising and showing their market animals. All animals will be weighed and entered into weight classes. Showmanship will be based on the age of the exhibitor as of January 1, 2009.

GENERAL SHOW RULES

1. Entry is open to any bona fide 4-H, FFA, or Jr. Breed Association member. Exhibitors must not have passed their 20th birthday on 1/1/09.
2. The entry fee is \$25 per animal when pre-entered. No refunds. Entries must be postmarked no later than June 5, 2009. The entry fee must accompany the official entry blank or a late fee of \$10 will be added.
3. **Late entries will be charged an additional \$10 to total \$35. Late entries will be cash only.**
4. There will be no limit on number of entries per exhibitor.
5. Barns will be open to receive entries after 1:00 PM on Friday, June 12, 2009.

All entries must be on the grounds and must be checked in by 8:00 Beef, 12 noon Sheep and 9:00 Hogs am Saturday, June 20, 2009

6. Bedding will be wood chips or shavings. **No straw will be allowed!**. Over night guest bedding will be available additional shavings will available for purchase at the show.
7. Each exhibitor must show his/her own animal. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**
8. All persons showing must be clean and neatly attired. Collared shirts are **MANDATORY**. No T-Shirts or Scoop collared blouses allowed, **NO EXCEPTION**. (No uniforms required.)
9. Showmanship will be in three age divisions: Junior-12 and under Intermediate-13-15, Senior-16 and over. The showmanship finals will be held at the conclusion of the show. Animal and Exhibitor must be entered in a Jackpot class together to be eligible for Showmanship.
10. The Show Management reserves the right to change the show schedule and classes to improve the show.

Tulelake-Butte Valley Fair policy prohibits the use of alcohol on the grounds. No smoking will be allowed in the barns area. The show committee reserves the right to remove any competitor or spectator for any conduct in which the committee feels reflects poorly on the event.

CATTLE

1. Class premiums will be paid to 4th place in each class
2. Heifers must be born after April 8, 2006 and will be assigned to classes by the show committee based on age. Heifers must be accompanied by registration papers or a copy of transfer papers or an affidavit of transferee of registration papers from their National Breed Association in the 4-H or FFA members name as of the show date. There will be a commercial heifer class for all unregistered heifers.
3. Weigh-in will be from 6:30 - 8:00 a.m. **Late entries will be charged an additional \$10 to total \$35 Late entries will be cash only. No Exceptions** Steers will be broken into two class divisions after weigh-in. Divisions will be: Prospect, Progress.
4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Out of state entries must conform to all rules and regulations of interstate shipment to California.
5. There will be a separate class for Klamath, Modoc and Siskiyou County exhibitors in the market division. (Bred and Fed)
6. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave after the completion of the show. Pens must be cleaned out. Shovels and Wheelbarrows will be available.

LAMBS

1. Class premiums will be paid to 4th place in each class
2. Animals must be slick sheared with no more than 10 days fleece prior to weigh-in. Market Lambs only.
3. Weigh backs may be asked for at the discretion of the judge.
4. HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Out of state entries must conform to all rules and regulations of interstate shipment to California.
5. Any animal showing evidence of Soremouth, Footrot or Active Club Lamb Fungus will be asked to leave the fairgrounds immediately.
6. Weigh-in will be from 12:00 - 12:30 pm. **Late entries will be charged an additional \$10 to total \$35. Late entries will be cash only. No Exceptions.**
7. Jackpot lambs must show lambs teeth.
8. Lambs will be broken into two class divisions after weigh-in. Divisions will be: Prospect, Progress.
9. There will be a separate class for Klamath, Modoc and Siskiyou County exhibitors in the market division. (Bred and Fed)
10. Ewes must be born after January 1, 2008 and will be assigned to classes by the show committee based on age.
11. Exhibitors will be allowed to leave after the completion of the show. Pens must be cleaned out. Shovels and Wheelbarrows will be available.
