ATTENTION FAIR TIME RV PARK CAMPERS:

Please read, as there have been changes.

Camping Fees:

Full hook ups September 7-13, 2009	\$90.00
Tent camping September 7-13, 2009	\$50.00
Dry Camping September 7-13, 2009.....	\$12.00 per night
Vehicles or storage trailers	\$12.00 per night
Units over 32 feet	additional \$5.00 per night

All overnight camping units located anywhere on the fairgrounds must be paid for (even outside fences or lawn) prior to parking.

All persons wishing to stay on the fairgrounds must register by completing a Fair Time RV Park Application prior to the fair. Spaces will not be reserved without the completed application and payment.

No recreational vehicle may go over the allotted length/width allowed in a space due to fire lane restrictions. The total length and width must be accurate on the application or you may be asked to remove your recreational vehicle from the RV Park.

A campground Attendant will be in charge of the camping area and will be available to direct you. You **MUST** check in with the attendant upon your arrival. **DO NOT park without the campground attendant or someone from the office giving you permission.** Please understand that just one trailer in the wrong place will throw everything off.

We are taking reservations again this year. You will have a space reserved for you, but if you request a certain space, we cannot guarantee that you will be placed in that space, but will make every effort to do so. The campground attendant has the right to assign spaces and change any assignment as that person best sees fit.

If you are part of a group wishing to be placed together, we ask that you communicate to arrive in pairs so that the back unit can be place first. Please call if you have any questions regarding this “buddy system.” We do our best to keep 4-H clubs, etc. in designated areas. You may want to bring any extension cords, adapters, water hoses, and faucet y’s that you may need for hookup.

We are also putting a limit on size. If your unit is more that 32 feet, you must contact the office for special placement. Units over 32 feet will be charged an additional \$5.00 per night.

Because of security, many commercial vendors ask to have their units storing merchandise parked inside the fences. Due to limited space, we must also charge per night for these vehicles.

Any vehicles with or in front of your camping unit or anywhere inside the fences must be paid as using separate space and must be approved. There must be open fire lanes for an easy exit. We prefer that you park extra vehicles including horse trailers out side the fences, whenever possible, to allow room for camping units.

No Dogs or alcohol are allowed on the fairgrounds. Adult supervision (over 21) is required at each camping unit. Violations will be handled by the campground attendant and Fair Management with immediate expulsion from the fairgrounds.

After we receive your payment, a camping and/or parking permit will be available for you to pick up when you arrive at the fair either from the fair office or the campground attendant. The permit(s) must be displayed in your window showing that you have paid.

Access to the trailer area will be through the Park Street gate at the northwest end of the fairgrounds. Parking and camping for horse show participants will be at the south end of the fairgrounds under the trees along the track.
